In a New Song Boom Town service we challenge kids to go deeper in their connection with God through fun and high-energy activities.

TOP FIVE THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

1 THE SERVICE EXPERIENCE

Our primary goal in New Song Kids is to have fun and know God in a safe environment. This is achieved through age-appropriate lessons specifically catered and designed for each classroom. Each room has a separate service flow that they follow every week specific to the age group. This ensures that no matter who is teaching, children still experience the same level of ministry.

2 WE DO PRAYER

At the end of every Boom Town service, we give kids the opportunity to give to God through their tithes and offerings, and to ask leaders for prayer about specific needs in their lives.

3 WE HAVE FUN

In our Boom Town class we believe that God's word is powerful! We speak our churches word declaration, sing and dance while worshiping, and play hilarious games. Kids receive various prizes for things like bringing their bibles, or for sitting quietly in class.

4 HEALTH AND WELLNESS

At NSK we do not allow our volunteers to administer medicine. In an emergency we will call parents if kids need medicine. Children with visible symptoms or fever are not allowed in the classroom. We ask parents not to bring their kids if they have a fever of 100 degrees and above, or visible symptoms such as vomiting. This policy is also applied to all ministry volunteers. In addition, our policy on bathroom breaks remains the same across all classrooms. Breaks for using the restroom are built into service for children, and male volunteers are never allowed to escort children to the bathroom.

5 TAKE IT HOME

New Song's Boom Town kids are encouraged to practice learning the word of God. After each service at pick-up kids will receive a 'replay' sheet of message notes. We ask our kids to fill out this sheet at home, and return the following Sunday with the correct answers in order to earn prizes at service. Our vision is to see kids going deeper with God every week they come to class.
